In December 1992 he founded Global Systems Networking and served as its Chief Executive Officer through the acquisition by Sweden-based Ericsson Corporation (www.ericsson.com) in May 1993. From May 1983 to March 1992 he was a Telecommunications and Computer Engineer in the United States Air Force, responsible for Airborne Warning and Control Systems and Combat Operations.
