Per capita income is the average income computed for every man, woman, and child in a particular group. The Census Bureau derived per capita income by dividing the total income of a particular group by the total population in that group (excluding patients or inmates in institutional quarters).

BEA Per capita personal income is income received by persons from all sources. It is calculated as the sum of wage and salary disbursements, supplements to wages and salaries, proprietors' income with inventory valuation and capital consumption adjustments, rental income of persons with capital consumption adjustment, personal dividend income, personal interest income, and personal current transfer receipts, less contributions for government social insurance. This measure of income is calculated as the personal income of the residents of a given area divided by the resident population of the area.

Base Industry Description: Base industry activities are the main drivers of the economy of a county or region, and are differentiated from other economic sectors by their ability to generate a flow of new income and spending on which the others depend. Base Industry Analysis measures money that comes in to an area from the outside of that area. This outside money is the basic, or direct, effect. The indirect effect is support of the businesses that bring in outside money.
